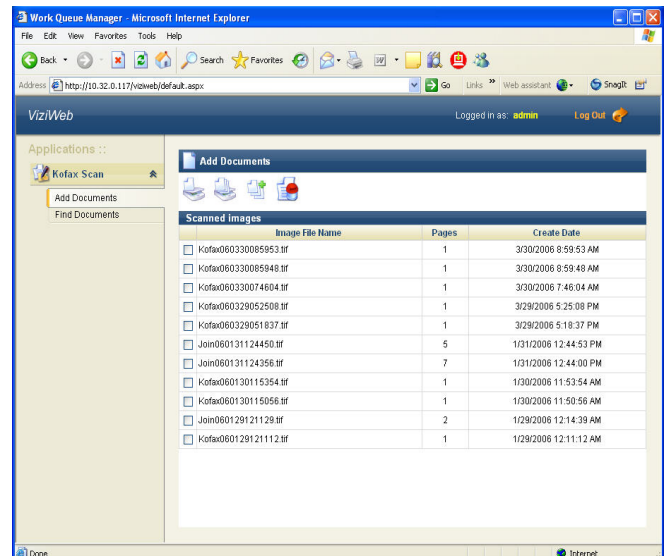
What is VisiWeb?

VisiWeb is a true “zero-footprint” document scanning software solution. VisiWeb is designed for today’s ad-hoc and remote scanning environments. VisiWeb gives you the ability to easily capture paper-based information throughout your organization – no matter where they’re located.

Why do I need VisiWeb?

Industry analysts tell us that more than 90% of the world’s information is managed via paper. In fact, you are likely dealing with more paper now than ever before.

The real problem with that is paper, due to its very nature is inefficient. The fact is, you probably don’t really care about the paper itself as much as the information that resides on the paper. Therefore, if there were a way to quickly “capture” the paper and accurately extract the key information you need to run your business, you could lower your operating costs, increase productivity, or even increase revenues.



Also, if your organization is like many others, you may have remote offices in many different locations – perhaps in other countries. They are probably dealing with the same paper documents you are, only they don’t have the resources of the central office, yet their documents may be critical to a business process. How do you help them get their paper-based information into the system while efficiently deploying and managing the software they need to complete the task?

With VisiWeb, you can quickly and easily enable any user in any location that has access to your network and an internet connection. There are no applets, or remote software applications to install and manage and everything can be managed from one central location. Users simply launch VisiWeb from their browser, log in and start scanning.

Other companies provide thin-client scanning, so what’s so great about VisiWeb?

Great question! We would answer this by first defining the difference between “thin-client” scanning and “zero-footprint” scanning. Thin-client scanning refers to the ability to scan documents via a web browser. However, many of these applications require the user to download a “small” applet, or Active-X file. Many times these small additions can cause performance issues and create additional management responsibilities for your IT department. Zero-footprint scanning is exactly that – nothing added. IT controls the loading, management and distribution of the application. This keeps costs down and gives you the ability to enable an unlimited number of remote users very quickly. And because VisiWeb is so easy to use, users are up and running in a matter of minutes.

A few more important differences include:

- Absolutely NO DONGLES – not even on the server!
- Very easy to understand licensing model – no volume restrictions
- Fully integrated with Kofax’s Document Scan Server™ technology
- In addition to scanning, VisiWeb allows users to search documents from any repository, i.e., FileNet, Documentum, SharePoint, Hyland, Oracle, IBM, and others.

I already have another scanning application, so how can I benefit from VisiWeb?

VisiWeb was designed for ad-hoc and remote scanning needs and where a “zero-footprint” application is desired. In some cases, adding another scanning station - local or remote - to an existing solution can cost thousands of dollars, which may make the return on investment unreasonable. Images from VisiWeb can be stored on a local drive, sent to a watched folder on the network, or released directly to a content repository, so there would be no interruption with your current scanning solution. In fact, images from VisiWeb can also be sent directly to an advanced forms solution for further processing, i.e., OCR, categorization, auto-separation, etc. We’ll even let you try VisiWeb at no cost, because we know that once you see how easy it is to use you’ll want to own it.

What scanners does VisiWeb support?

VisiWeb supports any industry standard TWAIN scanner*. VisiWeb also supports Kofax’s Document Scan Server™, which supports several of the industry’s most popular desktop scanners, including Fujitsu and Visioneer.
